### I'm Getting Notices for People Still Employed

I'm getting notices for unemployment claims for people still employed - who never filed a claim. What do I do?

1. Call the Hotline to Report
2. RESPOND to all notices received, stating "fraud/identity theft".
3. Share resources with Employees right away.

**DON'T IGNORE NOTICES.** Undisputed claims can have an affect on your State Unemployment Rates starting in 2021. ODJFS asserts that once a claim has been determined to be fraudulent, any mutualized charges will be removed from the employer's account.
